## Proposed JTC1/SC7 Standing Document:

# **Title Conventions for SC7 Standards and Technical Reports**

#### 1 Scope

Titles of SC7 developed standards and technical reports.

## 2. Requirements

- 2.1 Titles shall adhere to the ISO/IEC conventions for titles ( Ref. 1).
- 2.2 The titles of shall consist of two or more elements with each element separated by a "-".
- 2.3 Element 1 of a title shall be the characters "Software engineering".

#### Note:

Exceptions to the above requirements may be obtained by request from the SC7 Advisory Group.

#### 3. Implementation Considerations

#### 3.1 Changes to Element 1 of Titles

The following {information technology, information processing, information processing systems} would be replaced by "software engineering".

#### 3.2 Changes to Element 2 of Titles

In most cases the term "software" or phrase "software engineering" would be removed from the element 2 titles.
