Liaison Message from SC7 SLG2 to SC27
(on behalf of SC7 Plenary Meeting on 25-29 May, 2009)

SC7 SLG2 (Special Liaison Group 2) would like to express liaison intention concerning three liaison documents from SC27 as follows.

1) Liaison Response to SC27N7294rev1

Concerning collaboration between the ISO/IEC 20000 project and the ISO/IEC 27000 project, SC7/WG25 has continuous contact with SC27/WG1 including co-editorship possibility. SC7 hopes and supports success of such collaborations.

2) Liaison Response to SC27N7337

For the liaison document SC27/N7337 ("Liaison Officer's presentation"), SC7 will circulate the document to all WGs expecting WGs will check the contents of that overall introductory documents. SC7 think if a WG will find any collaboration theme in the document, it should communicate with SLG2 or directly with SC27(WGs). The chairman of SC7, the secretariat of SC7 and the convener of SLG2 should be notified of such direct communications.

3) Liaison Response to SC27N7176

For the Liaison document SC27/N7176 ("Application Security"), the project may has possibility to have some relationship with following themes;

- - Software Process (related standards are ISO/IEC 12207 and ISO/IEC 15288),
- - Software Assurance (related standard is ISO/IEC 15026),
- - Other software/systems engineering themes.

So SC7 wishes to have intimate communication with SC27 on this project theme. SC7 has already issued following liaison proposal.

1) "ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 7/WG 7 liaison with ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 27/WG 4 regarding the development of ISO/IEC 27034, Information technology – Security techniques – Application security"

SC7 has also issued related following liaison message.

2) “ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 7/WG 7 liaison with ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 27/WG 3 regarding the development of ISO/IEC TR 29193, Information technology – Security techniques – Secure system engineering principles and techniques”
